

90.09: Ordinance regarding sanitary requirements of pens, coops, stables and enclosures

It shall be unlawful for any person to maintain any pen, coop, stable or enclosure, including fenced-in yards (enclosed by a fence), in which animals are kept in a manner as to produce obnoxious odors or which is or may become a breeding place for flies or mosquitoes.

The owner or occupant of any premises on which animal(s) are kept in an enclosure(s) shall be required to maintain the enclosure(s) in a clean and healthful manner at all times, and all manure or other waste matter removed from the pen, coop, stable or enclosure shall be immediately hauled from the town or stored in suitable fly-proof bins or pits or buried under at least six inches of earth.
