Re: Weekly Report

Parking Lot Project Update – During the grading this week, the contractor encountered an area that had been used to dump bricks and debris, as well as an area of soil that seemed to be contaminated with a petroleum fuel. Both of these instances will result in slow-downs while the soil is made suitable for compaction.

Gym Painting – The painting at the gym has been completed. The white areas on the upper half of the gym walls was repainted white and that has really freshened up the interior of the gym.

Museum – I neglected to mention in last week's report that Anne Martin and I had met with Jason Luker at the Museum to discuss events scheduled by both the Town and Museum from the remainder of the year, as well as some possible events under consideration for 2017. It was a good meeting and we plan to meet again at the first of November. As discussions progress, I will be bringing more substantial information to you about specific events under consideration.

Fiscal Year 2016 Audit – Auditors with Lowdermilk Church have completed their on-site field work. Staff will be gathering some additional information to forward to them in the coming week as they pull together their data and prepare the audit documents.

Health Fair Held at Fire Department – The Health Fair sponsored by the Save Our Children Movement was held at the Fire Department on Saturday, September 17th as approved. There were 10 children that participated in the event.
